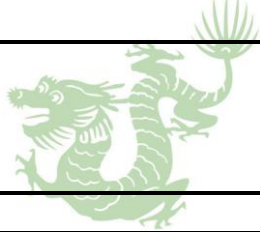
### ❖ **KIT (Keeping it together) Zone**

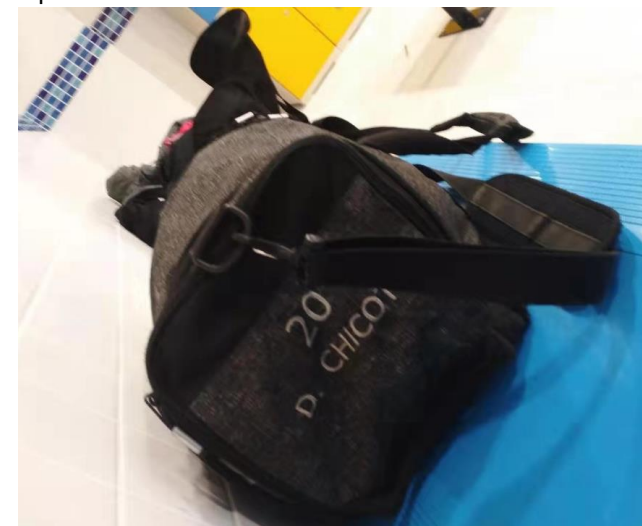
### Lost & Found

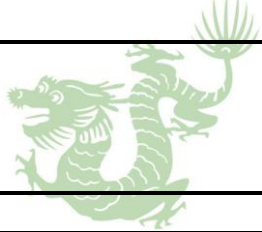
