Come and help to sort the clothes and put them into larger bags and ship off to other places in China. Please come to Ms. Wang C004 for details and signing up.

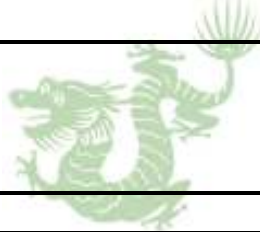

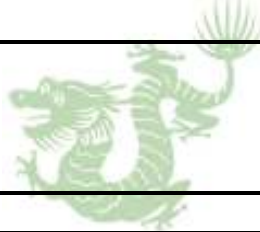
- High School Soccer games this week:
