Grade 10 will be on internships for 3 days, and then 2 days exploring their future Diploma Programme (Blalock & Simmons)

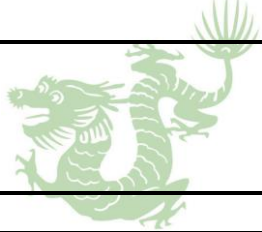
