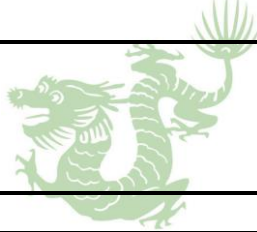


❖ [MYP 1-3 \(Grades 6-8\) MathCounts ASA](#)
