- Do you want a teacher around to help you complete your work?

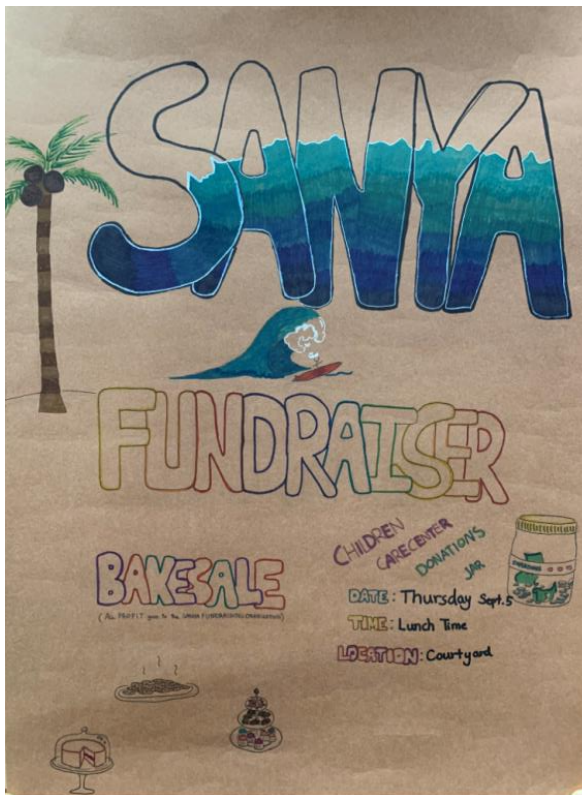
K.I.T. (Keep It Together) Zone is a place where you can do all of the above!

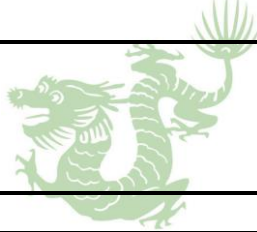

Lost & Found

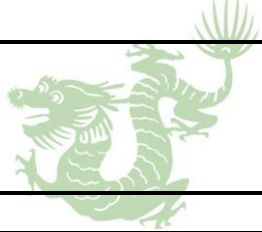
“Lost and Found” is located at the basement of Bldg. A, unclaimed items will be donated to charity every month.
