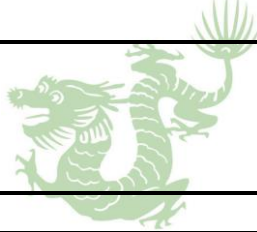

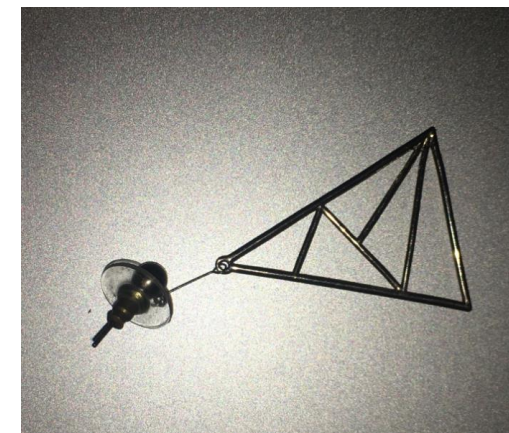
Lost & Found

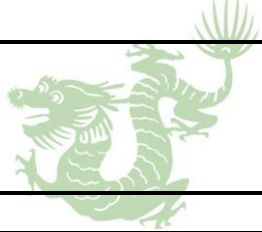
"Lost and Found" is located at the basement of Bldg. A, unclaimed items will be donated to charity every month.
