G5 PYP Exhibition

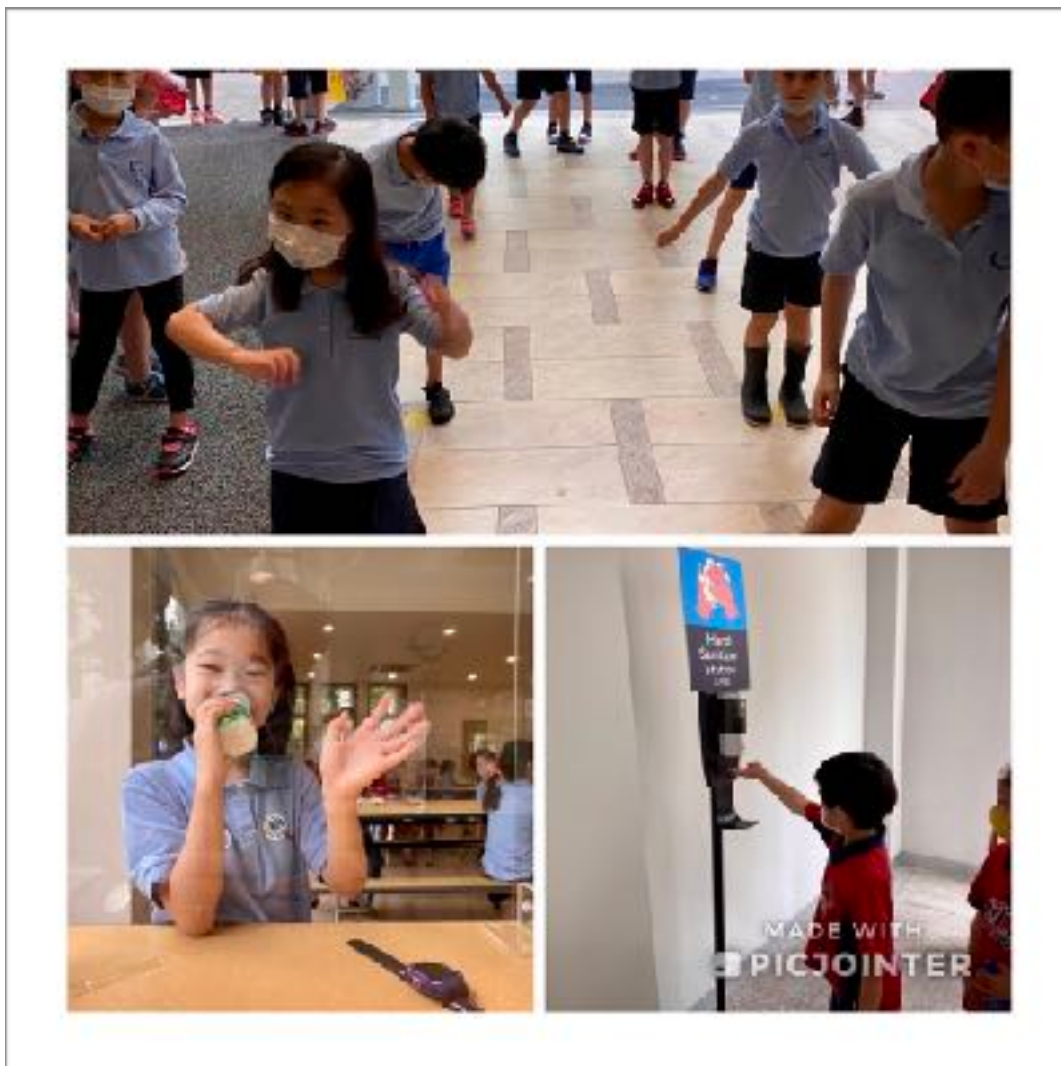
